** The entry fee includes one ticket for you for the Awards Banquet scheduled for the evening of Saturday, May 16th. These will be distributed at registration. Extra tickets may be purchased [click here](#)

** [Entry and Release Form](#) is included with this letter in a computer fillable form. Your company contact also has this form. Please complete this form as soon as possible and return it to your company contact. ***This form must be returned to the Wisconsin Motor Carriers Association with a current MVR. There will be no changes to this form accepted the day of competition. All forms must be completed by Friday, May 8th, 2026.***

You may not compete in the competition without a completed and signed Entry and Release Form and submitted MVR.

Please be advised that all contestants must have the appropriate class of Commercial Drivers License (CDL), and any required endorsements, for the class in which that person is competing. This will be verified with your MVR.

** **A copy of 2026 Facts For Drivers is to be individually purchased by your company [HERE](#).** The information in the book is the basis for the written exam. Study it thoroughly. You may get an audio cd of this book at <http://www.atabusinesssolutions.com>.

** The "Truck Driving Championships Safe Driver" shoulder patch is being sent to your company representative by US Mail. Please affix the patch to the left shoulder of the uniform, jacket, or shirt you will be wearing at the competition.

** Please try to arrive at Fox Valley Technical College early enough on Friday, so you will have plenty of time to register. All drivers must register on Friday. **Tractors for each class of competition will be available during registration from 4:00 – 5:00 p.m. for inspection by participants.**

** Please be advised, we will begin at 5 PM Friday, May 15th with the driver meeting then the written test and course walk-through. Attending the walk-through is not mandatory, but to miss it will likely put you at a competitive disadvantage for the driving portion of the contest. **THERE WILL BE NO COURSE WALK-THROUGH CONDUCTED ON SATURDAY MORNING.**

** **Any participant caught by a WTDC Official talking about Pre-Trip Inspection problems to other drivers on Saturday or otherwise compromising the event will cause their company to be ineligible for the Team Trophy!**

** **No cellphones or other devices are allowed in any part of the competition! Leave your cellphone or wearable communication device with your spouse, company official, hotel room or at home! There will be a drop box provided at concessions if you forget.**
